

YOUR UTILITY BILL DE**Mist**IFIED

INSIDE CITY LIMITS

Clear away the fog surrounding the water tier structure, learn how your rates are calculated, and get help reducing your use to keep your bill low.

WATER TIERS MADE CLEAR

Based on single-family lots inside city limits. Water rates effective April 1, 2022.

TIER 1 INDOOR WATER USE

Tier 1 reflects the amount of water allotted for your home's indoor use. This is based on the monthly average amount of water used in your household between the months of November and February. This is called your Average Winter Consumption (AWC).

If your use hasn't exceeded your AWC, your rate will be \$5.66 per 1,000 gallons.

TIER 3 HIGH LEVEL WATER USE

If your bill shows that you are in Tier 3, your use has exceeded the amount of water that has been allocated for outdoor use. Tier 3 allotment is 20,000 gallons. *If your use exceeds your AWC plus your MOA, you will be charged a rate of \$8.49 per 1,000 gallons.*

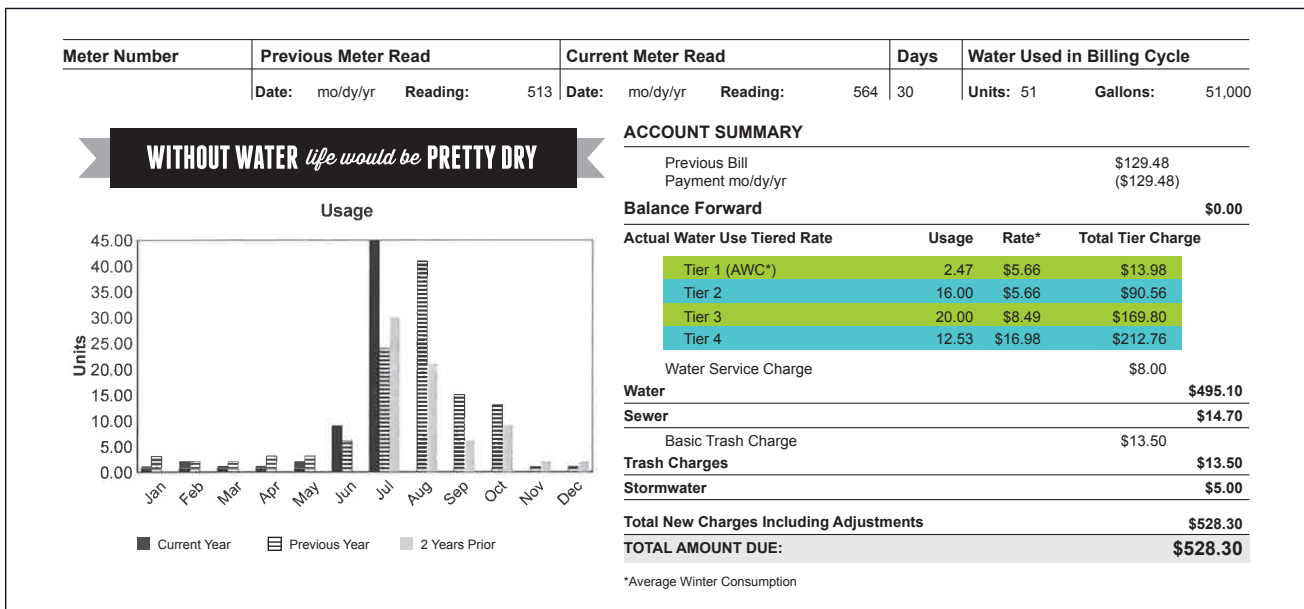
TIER 2 OUTDOOR WATER USE

Your outdoor water use is allocated using a Monthly Outdoor Allowance (MOA) based on lot size. This is the amount of water needed to sufficiently water an average-sized yard in Thornton.

If your use hasn't exceeded AWC plus your MOA, your rate will be \$5.66 per 1,000 gallons.

TIER 4 EXCESSIVE WATER USE

If your water use exceeds your AWC (indoor allocation) plus two times your MOA (outdoor allocation) *you will be charged a rate of \$16.98 per 1,000 gallons.*



WHY USE TIERS?

Staying within the average tier structure can help you use water more efficiently and it allows you flexibility to adjust your usage habits. Tiered Rates are based on the average amount of water needed inside your home and on the amount of water needed to sufficiently water the average size lawn in Thornton.

LOT SIZE APPENDIX

Lot Size is calculated based on Adams County records Land Valuation Summary. Adams County measurement is acres so the value is multiplied by 43,560 to convert to square feet.

- № 5** Water during cooler hours of the day.

PRACTICE SAVING.

Turn off the faucet when you brush your teeth, only do full loads of laundry, upgrade to a WaterSense toilet, and convert one zone of your landscape to a water-wise garden.
